Innovative Training & Sensory Support:

Specialized Training: Early voting managers will be equipped with specialized training for the statewide primaries, ensuring they're prepared to offer necessary accommodations to neurodivergent visitors to BVRE's early voting centers.

Identification Badges: These trained managers will be identifiable by badges and lanyards, signaling their readiness to assist.

Sensory Kits: Just Bee will provide sensory kits at BVRE's early voting centers to support those with sensory processing needs.

Bee Hive Sensory Safe Zone:

Traveling Safe Space: For select days and hours during the early voting period, Just Bee's Bee Hive Sensory Safe Zone will be available at two of BVRE's early voting centers.

A Refuge for Sensory Overload: The Bee Hive offers a tranquil space for individuals experiencing sensory overload and a comfortable waiting area for voters' companions.
