

CHARLESTON COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD DISTRICT 4 SPECIAL ELECTION

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Voters who live in Charleston County School Board District 4 have two separate elections available to vote in:

- Primary Election - available to all eligible voters at all locations.
- Charleston County School District 4 Special Election - only available to voters residing within the CSSD 4.

Eligible voters can vote in the Primary Election, the School District 4 Special Election, or both.

How do I vote in the School Board District 4 Election?

As the School Board District 4 Election and the Primary Election are separate elections, you must cast a separate ballot for each election. If you'd like to vote in the School Board District 4 Election:

1. Let a poll worker know which election(s) you would like to vote in.
2. If you are voting in the Primary Election, check in and receive your ballot for that election.
3. Cast your ballot for the Primary Election.
4. Check in and receive your ballot for the School Board District 4 Election.
5. Cast your ballot for the School Board District 4 Election.

Where can I vote in the School Board District 4 Special Election?

- You can vote early at the Charleston County Board of Elections Headquarters (4340 Corporate Road, N Charleston, SC 29405). Polls are open May 26 - June 5, Monday - Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- You can vote at your assigned polling location on Tuesday, June 9. Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Will I be able to vote curbside for the School Board District 4 Election?

Yes, qualified voters can vote in both the School Board District 4 Election and the Primary Election via curbside voting.

If I already voted in the Primary Election, can I still vote in the School Board District 4 Election?

Yes. Voting in the Primary Election will not impact your eligibility for the School Board District 4 Election.

How do I know if I'm eligible for the School Board District 4 Special Election?
