

How Can I Register?



In Person

You can register at our office, or at other government offices like the DMV.



Online

If you have a SC driver's license or ID with your current address, you can register online at [SCVotes.gov](https://scvotes.gov).



Mail/Email/Fax

You can send us a completed voter registration form via mail, email, or fax.



Registration Deadline

You must be registered at least 30 days before an election to be eligible to vote.

How Can I Vote?



Early Voting

Vote early at any Charleston County early voting location.



Election Day

Vote at your assigned polling location on Election Day.



Absentee by Mail

If you qualify to vote absentee, you can vote by mail.

When Do I Vote?

Elections take place every year in Charleston County. To view upcoming elections, visit CHSVotes.gov.

Where Do I Vote?

If you are voting in person, you can vote early at any Charleston County early voting location.

You can also vote at your assigned polling place on Election Day.

Headed to College?




You can register to vote using your home address or your school address. The choice is yours.

Don't You Have to be 18 to Register?

In South Carolina, you can register to vote if you will be 18 on or before the date of the next General Election.

Get Paid to Serve

You can earn money and serve your community as an election worker. To be an election worker, you must:

-  Be a registered SC voter
-  Attend training
-  Work the entire Election Day

Photo ID Requirements

You cannot use a student ID to vote in SC. You'll need a valid, unexpired photo ID such as a:

- SC Driver's License or DMV ID Card
- US Passport or Passport Card
