I'M REGISTERED TO VOTE, NOW WHAT?



How can I vote?

- Early Voting: Vote early at any early voting location in Charleston County.
- **Election Day:** Vote at your assigned polling location on Election Day.
- **Absentee by Mail:** If you're 65 or older, have a physical disability, or have another qualifying reason, you may vote by mail.

You can request an absentee ballot by phone, in person, or via mail. Our office must receive completed applications 11 days before Election Day by 5:00PM.

What do I need to bring with me to vote?

You will need to show a valid, unexpired photo ID that falls under one of the following categories:

- SC Driver's License
- SC DMV ID Card
- US Passport Book or Card
- SC Voter Registration Card with Photo
- Federal Military ID

*If you have a **limited-term** DMV ID, you must bring another acceptable ID or proof of citizenship to vote.
