Double Traffic Fatality on Highway 61

(West Ashley, SC) Just before 3:30 p.m. today, Charleston County sheriff's deputies responded to a two-car motor vehicle collision in the 4100 block of Highway 61, near Magnolia Plantation. A Jeep travelling at a high rate of speed southbound (towards Charleston) crossed the center line and struck, nearly head-on, a northbound Chevrolet. Unfortunately, the drivers of both vehicles died at the scene. A dog in the Chevrolet also died in the collision. There were no other occupants in the vehicles. The collision shut down both directions of Highway 61 for several hours. The Traffic Division is investigating the collision.
