Fourth arrest in Corral Drive homicide

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Charleston County deputies on Monday, Dec. 6, 2021, arrested a fourth suspect in connection with a July 19 homicide on Corral Drive in West Ashley.

Rico Jamall Ancrum, 19, was captured by fugitive task force members during a traffic stop on Savannah Highway. He was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Sheriff Al Cannon Detention Center. He is expected to have a bond hearing Tuesday morning.

Detectives had arrested three other suspects — all of whom are juveniles — in late October. All four suspects face a murder charge.

Deputies responded around 3:30 p.m. July 19 to 766 Corral Drive and found the victim, Dontae Greene, lying on the ground. He had been shot.

Detectives gathered witness information indicating the four suspects all occupied a truck used in the shooting and were heard discussing the homicide after the fact.
