CCSO investigates Sol Legare hit-and-run fatality

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Investigators from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office are seeking information in a hit-and-run crash that killed a pedestrian early Tuesday.

Deputies responded about 2:30 a.m. to Sol Legare Road near Crozet Drive. They determined that the pedestrian was walking on the road when he was hit by a vehicle that fled the area. The pedestrian was then struck by another vehicle, which also left the scene, according to witness information. The second vehicle was later located during a traffic stop by Charleston police in downtown Charleston.

The pedestrian was transported to MUSC, where he died.

The Charleston County Coroner's Office will provide the pedestrian's identity information when available.

UPDATE July 6, 2022

Deputies are aware of a nearby gathering that the victim had left before the crash. They continue to investigate to determine the extent of the connection.

No arrests have been made. The vehicle that initially struck the pedestrian has not been identified, and there is no description available.
