## In-custody death of Detention Center resident

**NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C.** – A resident at the Al Cannon Detention Center who was hospitalized last week has died.

While conducting a security check about 6 a.m. Dec. 21, detention deputies found the man who appeared to be breathing but unresponsive in a cell. The deputies declared a medical emergency, and EMS transported the resident to MUSC. He died Thursday at the hospital.

Per protocol, the Office of Professional Standards at the Charleston County Sheriff's Office is conducting an internal review. CCSO detectives also are investigating. There is no evidence of foul play.

The man had been held at the Detention Center since August on multiple charges, including first-degree assault and battery and first-degree burglary, among others. The Charleston County Coroner's Office can provide identity information when appropriate.
