Man wounded in stabbing at James Island bar

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Detectives from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office continue to investigate a stabbing that wounded one person earlier this week at a James Island bar.

Deputies responded about 2:20 a.m. Wednesday to The Hideout Bar & Grill at 1006 Folly Road, where they found a victim who was bleeding from the neck. The man was transported by EMS to MUSC for treatment of wounds that were serious but not believed to be life-threatening.

A suspect had left before deputies arrived.

An initial investigation revealed the victim and another man were involved in a verbal dispute that turned physical. The victim was cut during the ensuing altercation.

No arrests have been made. Detectives continue to gather information regarding the circumstances of the incident.

UPDATE Thursday, Jan. 26, 2023

Travis Derod Shaver, 38, turned himself in Thursday morning on charges of attempted murder and possession of a weapon during a violent crime in connection with this stabbing. He was booked at the AI Cannon Detention Center. Video evidence showed that Shaver stabbed the victim in the neck during an altercation.
