Oceanview Road murder-attempted suicide

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Deputies from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office responded around 3:35 p.m. today to reports of a shooting in the 1200 block of Oceanview Road on James Island. At the scene, they found one person dead and a second person seriously wounded. The wounded person was taken to a local hospital. Detectives are investigating the circumstances of the shooting, but there is not believed to be any danger to the community.

UPDATE Jan. 4, 2022

The Charleston County Sheriff's Office is investigating the shooting Monday afternoon, Jan. 3, 2022, on James Island as a murder and attempted suicide.

Deputies responded around 3:35 p.m. to 1234 Oceanview Road for what initially was thought to be a medical call. Inside the home, they found a woman dead and a man suffering a serious gunshot wound. Deputies secured a firearm nearby.

The wounded man, John Thomas Schaefer, 56, was taken to MUSC, where he remains in Sheriff's Office custody while undergoing treatment. He will face a murder charge. Detectives believe he fatally shot the woman before shooting himself. He is expected to have a bond hearing once his condition improves. A booking photo is not available. The victim is the suspect's mother.
