Shooting and fatal crash on Johns Island

May 14, 2022

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Before 1 a.m. Saturday, May 14, 2022, deputies from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office responded to reports of a drive-by shooting on Michelle Lane on Johns Island. On scene, the deputies found damage from gunfire, but no one was injured. The deputies later determined that the shooter or shooters were on foot before leaving in a vehicle.

As deputies investigated shortly after 1 a.m., a sedan drove by the scene, and a complainant identified it as the vehicle involved in the shooting. A deputy found the car a short time later and attempted a traffic stop. The vehicle fled at high speed, and a short pursuit ensued. The deputy reported losing sight of the suspect vehicle and canceled the pursuit.

A short time later, the vehicle was found crashed into a tree near Brownswood Road and Dogpatch Lane. Two people from the vehicle died at the scene. The S.C. Highway Patrol responded to investigate the crash.

The complainant reported that an assault rifle was used in the shooting. A rifle fitting that description was found in the vehicle that crashed.
