McClellanville man arrested after domestic violence incident

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Deputies from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office responded shortly before 1 a.m. Sunday to a report of a domestic violence incident on Lineberry Lane in the McClellanville area.

A woman reported that her husband had threatened her and prevented her and her daughter's escape from the home. The woman and her adult daughter eventually got out of the house and called for help.

Responding deputies called out the husband, who emerged from the home. The man approached two deputies while holding a gun. He refused to drop the weapon and told the deputies to leave before eventually retreating into the home. After subsequent attempts to call out the man were not successful, the CCSO SWAT team and crisis negotiators responded to the scene.

The man walked out and surrendered without incident about 8 a.m. No injuries were reported.

Anthony Danny Mason, 51, was arrested and later booked at the Al Cannon Detention Center on charges of domestic violence of a high and aggravated nature, two counts of kidnapping and two counts of pointing and presenting a firearm.
