Beaufort man faces multiple charges in connection to Charleston hit-and-run

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Deputies with the Charleston County Sheriff's Office have arrested Lawrence Elijah Doe Junior, 40, of Beaufort, in connection to a hit-and-run incident that occurred in early August.

On Saturday, August 10, 2024, just after 11 p.m., deputies responded to the 10,000 block of Highway 78 in Ladson for reports of a hit-and-run collision involving a vehicle and a bicyclist. The victim was transported to Trident Medical Center for treatment of their injuries. Witnesses' descriptions of the suspected vehicle, combined with a database made available to law enforcement, found the vehicle involved was a silver pickup with South Carolina plates.

On Tuesday, August 13, 2024, deputies located the suspected vehicle and conducted a traffic stop. Doe was arrested for Driving Under Suspension on scene. A firearm was also discovered in the vehicle. After further investigation by the CCSO Traffic Unit, it was confirmed Doe was the driver of the vehicle on the night of the hit-and-run.

Doe is charged with Driving Under Suspension, Possession of a Firearm by a Prohibited Person, Hit and Run with Great Bodily Injury, Driving Left of the Center, Driver's Duties in a Collision, and Failing to Exercise Due Care Motor Vehicle.

Doe was given a \$83,500 bond during a hearing on the evening of Monday, August 26, 2024.
