CCSO releases video of in-custody death

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – The Charleston County Sheriff's Office is releasing security footage from the Sheriff Al Cannon Detention Center sally port area showing the period of time Andrew Kluczinsky, 50, was in custody for the charge of Receiving Stolen Goods. CCSO is also releasing dashcam video of the transport to the detention center. Shortly before midnight on Sunday, March 10, 2024, Kluczinsky was being prepared to be booked into the detention center when he suffered a medical event, resulting in his death.

Sally Port Video Timeline

23:42:36 – CCSO deputies check on the occupants of the patrol vehicle.

23:47:36 – Deputies pull Kluczinsky out of the patrol vehicle and onto the ground of the sally port.

23:50:38 – Medical professionals from the detention center arrive to begin life saving measures.

23:51:16 – Charleston County EMS pulls up to the sally port gate.

23:53:00 – EMS professionals take over life saving measures.

23:56:17 – The North Charleston Fire Department arrives.

00:03:32 – Kluczinsky is loaded into a Charleston County ambulance.

00:07:30 – The ambulance leaves the sally port, transporting Kluczinsky to Roper St. Francis Hospital where he is later pronounced dead.

The incident report is also included in this release.

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division is investigating Kluczinsky's death. Additionally, per protocol, the Office of Professional Standards at the Charleston County Sheriff's Office is conducting an internal review. CCSO detectives are also investigating.
