CCSO takes one adult, two juveniles into custody after armed robbery in Lincolville

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – The Charleston County Sheriff's Office (CCSO) has charged Elijah Lewis, 18, in connection with an armed robbery that occurred on Sunday, April 26, 2026, just after 2 p.m. in Lincolville.

Charleston County Deputies responded to the 900 block of Lincolville Road in response to reports of an armed robbery in progress. Dispatch advised that the four victims stated that they were held at gunpoint and were robbed by three suspects. Upon arrival, the victims on scene confirmed what they had told dispatch, and that the suspects took off in a silver Toyota Camry. The suspects' vehicle was traced back to the 100 block of Pike Drive in Summerville.

After multiple callouts by the Charleston County Sheriff's Office, one suspect, Lewis, exited the residence, surrendered, and was taken into custody without incident. Shortly after, two of the other suspects, both juveniles, also surrendered and were taken into custody without incident.

A search warrant for the home they were in was obtained. CCSO successfully located two firearms within the residence. No other items related to the armed robbery or contraband were located at the conclusion of the search.

Lewis was transported and booked into the Sheriff Al Cannon Detention Center. The two juveniles were transported and booked into the Charleston County Juvenile Detention Center.
