Paving Operations around Hampton Park and Bee Street in Downtown Charleston

UPDATE: Due to rain on Sunday night, Charleston County Public Works will be conducting nighttime paving operations on Mary Murray Drive on **Monday, July 31 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.** Mary Murray is the road that wraps around Hampton Park in downtown Charleston. It will be closed to pedestrians and drivers during that time.

Workers will put a clear coat on the road followed by light sand. This helps extend the life of the road by protecting it from water and sun. Crews will sweep up the sand, but it will be open prior to sweeping, so residents who choose to walk on Mary Murray before it is swept can expect to get sand on their shoes.

Crews will begin paving work on Bee Street in the medical district in downtown Charleston early in the morning on Wednesday, August 2. Parking on Bee Street between Courtney Drive and Rutledge Avenue will be prohibited until after the road is sprayed.

All work is weather permitting and schedules are subject to change.
