## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHARLESTON COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 1949, TO CORRECT THE ANNUAL SOLID WASTE RECYCLING AND DISPOSAL FOR FEE MULTI-FAMILY UNIT TO REMAIN UNCHANGED AT \$70.00 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2017.

**WHEREAS,** Charleston County Council ("County Council") enacted Ordinance Number 1949 on June 20, 2017, which provided approval of the Solid Waste Recycling and Disposal Fee for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017 for Charleston County; and

**WHEREAS,** County Council intended to leave the Solid Waste Recycling and Disposal Fee unchanged for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017; and

**WHEREAS,** Ordinance 1949 inadvertently reduced the Solid Waste Recycling and Disposal Fee for Multi- Family Units to \$66.00 each;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY CHARLESTON COUNTY COUNCIL that Charleston County

Ordinance No. 1949 is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION 1:** 

Section 3, subsection 1 is amended so that the Multi-Family Unit Annual Solid Waste Recycling and

Disposal Fee is \$70.00 each, such that subsection 1 shall read as follows:

Classification	Annual Solid Waste
of Property	<u>Recycling and Disposal Fee</u>
Single Family Residence	\$99.00 each
Multi-family Unit	\$70.00 each

1. <u>Residential Properties</u> -- the Annual Solid Waste Recycling and Disposal Fee (the "Fee" or "Fees") for Residential Properties shall be as follows:

<u>SECTION 2</u>: If any provision of this Ordinance or its applications to any circumstance is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid for any reason, this holding shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared by Council to be severable.

SECTION 3: The remainder of the original Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: This Ordinance shall take effect following approval of third reading. First Reading: October 24, 2017 Second Reading: November 2, 2017 Third Reading: December 5, 2017
